Lesson 1: Corporate Social Responsibility

Learners will be able to Will Be Able To (LWBAT): Provide examples of socially responsible business practices

Activity: Learner will answer 1 out of 1 knowledge check questions related to corporate social responsibility (Knowledge Check Question 5).

Activity: Learners will review how TOMS practices corporate social responsibility at this link (<u>https://www.toms.com/environment</u>).

Lesson 2: Vision and Mission Statements

LWBAT: Correctly answer 2 of 2 knowledge check questions.

Activity: Learner will answer 3 out of 3 knowledge check questions related to a vision and mission statement (Knowledge Check Questions 1, 2 and 3).

Activity: Learners will review TOMS Shoes mission and vision statements.

Activity: Learners will learn to differentiate between a mission statement (how the business operates) and a vision statement (what they're hoping to accomplish goal).

Activity: Learners will draft their own vision and mission statements in a Google Doc.

NOTE: The learner is not prompted to share the link to the Google Doc. As the instructor, it is your responsibility to prompt the learners to share the link to their Google Doc with you.

Activity: Answer 1 of 1 knowledge check questions correctly about nonprofits (Knowledge Check Question 4).

Knowledge Check and Reflection

LWBAT: Answer 5 out of 5 review questions correctly

Activity: Knowledge Check – 5 questions

Activity: Compare and contrast the learner's definition at the beginning of the module with the answer they provide at the end of the module.

Activity: Learners will create a Google Doc to review what they have learned in this module. The learner has been asked to address the following questions in their doc:

1. What is corporate social responsibility?

2. Pick a problem that you think is important, then find an organization that is working to address that issue. What is their mission statement?

3. What's the difference between nonprofit and for-profit?

4. If you could create your own business, what would it do? Would it be a nonprofit or for-profit organization? What would its vision be?

5. Write a draft mission statement (which includes the vision statement) for your organization.
